Directions

In Bride, at the roundabout by Bride Tea Rooms leave the A10 eastwards towards Cranstal/Point of Ayre on the A16. Take the first exit at the mini-roundabout to continue on the A16 northeastwards to Cranstal/Point of Ayre. Continue for 4.1km through Cranstal and *almost* to the road's end. (If you reach the junction of the concrete track to the lighthouse and turn-off to the Point of Ayre car park, retrace your route 100m back along the road.) Turn onto the rough stone on the west side of road. Drive alongside the tall chain-link fence and park at the western end of this track. (Red pin on map).

There is currently NO PUBLIC ACCESS to the reserve due health & safety restrictions and works in progress. Visiting is strictly by arrangement with and under the supervision of Manx BirdLife staff.

Paths in the reserve are ill-formed, rough and prone to waterlogging with occasional protruding objects in the ground. Especial care and firm footwear are required. There are no toilet facilities on site; the nearest public facilities are adjacent to Bride Tea Rooms. Dogs and unescorted children are not permitted in the reserve.
