An intermediate level course looking at migration of birds, why some migrate, how migration is fuelled, strategies for navigation – with an in-depth investigation of wildfowl (ducks, geese and swans)

Going beyond the basics of birdwatching, this intermediate level course is aimed at those with some birding experience, including past students of the *Introduction to Birdwatching* course. It will include an assignment in which students will be asked to research and observe a chosen species in some detail. Modules will include bird migration; fuel for mass movements; 'are we there yet' navigational strategies; and an in-depth study of Manx wildfowl.



Tim Earl is the course leader, starting on Thursday 27th January and comprising:

- three weekday evening classroom-based sessions (7.00 to 9.00pm approx.);
- and three weekend morning outdoor sessions.

Please note that field trips are subject to cancellation only in extreme weather conditions, so some flexibility and appropriate clothing might be required.

- Sunday 30th January, field trip time and location to be decided;

- Sunday 13 February, field trip time and location to be decided.
