This role is based at the Manx BirdLife Point of Ayre National Reserve.

The Manx BirdLife Point of Ayre National Reserve is currently open to the public two days a week (Wednesday and Sunday) from 9am until sunset. We are looking for enthusiastic, outgoing people to provide a friendly welcome to visitors to the reserve, help with any queries they may have and generally help them enjoy their visit in a responsible way.

You don't need to be a wildlife expert or even a birdwatcher for this role but you do need to be a 'people person' and have good communication skills. Full training and support will be provided for anyone taking part.

This role is flexible so there are no minimum commitments required but ideally we would like your help one morning or afternoon at least once a month. We will be looking to pair people up for this role so there will be no lone working required.

This is a really rewarding and enjoyable role. You will be working with a knowledgeable and friendly team on a beautiful nature reserve. You will get to meet lots of new people in this role, enjoying conversation and helping people have a wonderful visit. There is always the opportunity to learn new things and gain skills through volunteering, by working on a reserve, you'll naturally learn all about how nature reserves are managed and the wildlife that is found there.
